○**Program Period:**

August 1st – August 8th, 2018

○**Eligibility:**

- 1) Any students who are enrolled in educational institutions overseas including high schools, universities and language schools.
- 2) Students must be able to arrive at Fukuoka International Airport morning time on August 1st 2018.

*If you can't make it at that time on that day, then please arrive the day before. Please note that you must pay all the relevant expenses that might occur before the start of the official program on your own.

○**Schedule:**

○**The number of Participants:**

15 students

*This figure is not the one from each school but the upper limit we can accept from all institutions.

*If the number of applicants exceeds more than we expect, we will select the participants according the criteria such as academic grades.

*Basically we need at least total of 10 applicants to carry out the program. If there are fewer than 10 applicants the program might be canceled.

○**Program fee:**

80,000 JPY (including food, accommodation, airport pickup, etc)

*The fee might be adjusted in case we don't receive the minimum number of participants.

*Travel costs to Fukuoka from your home country, some meals, private expenses such as snacks and souvenirs must be paid out of your own pocket.

○**Application deadline:**

11th July, 2018 (Japan Time)
